THE VISION

The School of Evangelism is to equip and activate people to see the lost saved and transform Norwich and Norfolk.

Matt is on the core team of Europe Shall Be Saved (ESBS) with a focus on raising up and mobilising 10,000 evangelists across Europe. He was on staff at Bethel Church in California for four years. Matt takes delight in equipping and training the church in power evangelism. He is also a graduate of the Reinhard Bonnke School of Evangelism

Andrew Cannon is an evangelist born and raised in Liverpool. The hand of God touched him radically, transforming his life and instantly setting him free from a life of addictions on his very first encounter with the love and power of Jesus.
